Closure of the 2020-2021 Hunting Season

The Public is hereby notified of the closure of the 2020-2021 Hunting Season effective March 1st, 2021 and the following will apply:

- I. Hunting activity of game animals must be ceased on all lands of Trinidad and Tobago.
- II. Persons have until March 31st, 2021 to dispose of Game Animal carcasses (or any part thereof) from their property and or their possession.
- III. Holders of Hunting Permits purchased for the 2020-2021 Hunting Season must submit the Mandatory Data Return Forms on or before May 31st, 2021. Failure to comply may result in summary conviction of Five Thousand Dollars (TT\$5000.00) per data form.

Mandatory Data Forms can be submitted to any of the following stations:

NB. Following the Ministry's strict COVID -19 Protocol, persons may be required to use our drop-boxes at these locations and will be contacted by the Forestry Division in due course for the collection of their acknowledgement receipt.
